


PHYSICAL ASPECTS

This product has been designed to carry a patient from rescue site to the emergency vehicle. Caution should be taken at all times during this manoeuvre. Of utmost importance is having enough attendants available to carry the stretcher. Attendants must have these basic abilities and skills: to grasp firmly with both hands; have sufficient strength in back, arms, and legs to lift, push, and pull; good balance and reflexes; and muscular coordination. Use discretion when selecting attendants to carry the Folding Emergency Stretcher.

USING MODELS 108-A

Unroll stretcher and place next to the patient, Illustration 1.

USING MODELS 108-AF


Place stretcher on the ground and unroll. Grasp frames on both sides of the hinge and unfold stretcher lengthwise, Illustration 2.

ILLUSTRATION 2




MODEL 108-A & 108-AF

Grasp both sides of the stretcher and pull the frames apart, Illustration 4.



To hold the stretcher in the open position, there are two spreader bars which are pressed into place, locking the stretcher open, Illustration 5.



To close the stretcher, pull spreader bars in opposite direction from which they were opened. When tension of orange cover starts to relax, pull cover away from spreader bars. Close stretcher, wrapping orange cover around poles and put into storage.

CAUTION: BE CAREFUL TO AVOID PINCHING FINGERS IN THE SPREADER BARS.

KEEP COVER CLEAR OF HINGES TO PREVENT DAMAGE.

ACCESSORIES

Restraints, blankets, sheets, pillows, pillow cases, and a vinyl carry case are available. For more information, consult your catalogue or distributor.

MAINTENANCE


Establish a regular maintenance and inspection program. Such inspection should include looking for anything that might affect the integrity of the Folding Emergency Stretcher, e.g., bent or broken parts, torn vinyl/nylon cover, etc. If damage is found TAKE IT OUT OF SERVICE until repair or replacement can be made.

HOW TO MAINTAIN

Routine maintenance is minimal. Exposed metal surfaces are normally polished, plated, or otherwise treated for easy care and appearance. To protect these surfaces, clean as often as needed with soap and water or a mild solvent. Cleaning should be followed by a coat of good wax such as used on automobiles.
