AMBUS MULTI-PATIENT EVACUATION

Acadian Ambulance Service operates air and road ambulances and employs over 3,000 medics across Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas, USA. To further enhance their capabilities, Acadian commissioned two multi-patient vehicles or AMBUS — dedicated patient evacuation vehicles with the capacity to transport up to 20 patients at one time.

While based in separate states, both vehicles can be repositioned and sent to areas needing additional resources for natural disaster responses such as MCIs, evacuations and first-responder rehabilitation services during large scale events.

The Ambuses are fitted with iNTRAXX tracks, litter arms and mounts which enables patients to be safely secured vertically in the Ambus with very little effort. The iNTRAXX System also provides the ability to organise patients according to their medical needs for better patient care.
